ATTORNEY GENERAL’S REPORT

Lori Anthony presented the following information to Commissioners:

- Lori Anthony commented on the landmark decision where the Supreme Court upheld the Health Care Reform.
- Lori gave a follow-up to a housing case where a temporary restraining order filed the Attorney General’s office. The woman had a service animal for a physical and emotional disability. Her landlord had served eviction notice. Marilyn Tobocman obtained an agreement to the 600 unit residence. Charging Party determined she no longer wants to live there. Respondent is receiving Fair Housing Training and a policy providing for service animals will be provided to all tenants.
- Lori stated the Attorney General’s office is getting training from NAGTRI Facility. Duffy Jamieson is training for them and recently attended a meeting where he received at NAGTRI award.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Director Payton presented the following information to Commissioners:

- Director Payton stated that Brandi Martin was able to obtain the services of Cincinnati television news anchor and community leader Michelle Kearney to serve as our Mistress of Ceremony for our Fourth Annual Civil Rights Hall of Fame on October 4, 2012. Ms. Kearney is a strong supporter of equal rights. We have appeared on her television show numerous times over the years. She is the wife of State Senator Eric Kearney.
- Director Payton stated that the EEOC has begun a nationwide push to generate more systemic (e.g., criminal histories and employment) or pattern and practice cases. The EEOC's new focus on group-based claims is part of an overall effort to be more assertive in enforcement efforts.
- Director Payton stated we will soon be reengineering our website by changing its overall appearance and adding more portals for our users' information gathering. The site will have more content for visitors to our website. This effort is being led by Keith McNeil and Brandi Martin.
- Judia Brown presented Certificates of Completion to employees who participated in the State of Ohio Walking Challenge between April 16, 2012 and June 10, 2012. OCRC had 42 participants. OCRC placed 57th out of 215 State Agencies that participated.
- Director Payton recognized Iris Choi, Cleveland Regional Director and thanked her for her many years of outstanding service with OCRC. Today is Iris' last Commission Meeting, she will be retiring.


